(San Antonio) Four exciting events will be hosted on April 18th and 25th, to celebrate the unique culture and tradition of the Mexican sport of Charrería. The first set of events begin on the 18th of April will an Escaramuza display at 12:00 p.m. with our second event, a Charreada at 3:00 p.m., which will include Rey Feo and his court. On April 25th we will begin with an Escaramuza display at 12:00 p.m. and conclude with a Charreada at 3:00 p.m., which will include King Antonio and his court.

The fun takes place on the spectacular grounds of the Asociacion de Charros de San Antonio Ranch on the banks of the San Antonio River. The family friendly events will feature an exhibition presented by the Charro Association including spectacular bull riding events and a special performance of its female sidesaddle riding team, “Las Coronelas” and other Escaramuza teams. The Lienzo Charro is located at 6126 Padre Dr. near Mission San José. Witness the pageantry and skills of Charrería; take part in the celebration of culture with mariachis and ballet folklórico; and enjoy the variety of traditional food and drink.
